### PANORAMA OF THE THAMES PROJECT – SOCIAL CHANGE ALONG THE RIVER THAMES

John Inglis and Jill Sanders will give a brief introduction to this project, the aim of which is to create a visual record of the Thames riverside through London. They will then give a presentation about social and industrial changes along the Thames over the past two centuries. It is illustrated by the differences in various locations evident between the Leigh Panorama (1829) and the Thames photography (2014). They will explore the transformation of the London Thames from a largely working river of factories, wharves, fishing, osier growing, market gardening and transportation – and some fine houses – to the riverbanks and waterway we see today. The film *An Introduction to the Panorama of the Thames project* will also be shown and there will be an opportunity to buy the first book from the project entitled “A Riverside View of Georgian London”

Doors open at **6.45pm** and the presentation will start at **7.15pm** followed by a short break for refreshments before the AGM.
